### RS BOARD MEETING MINUTES

## March 26, 2009

#### **Board Meeting**

The meeting of the NC State Board of Sanitarian Examiners was held on Thursday, March 26, 2009 at the Transylvania County Public Library in Brevard NC. Called to Order – Chair Ann Gilstrap called the meeting to order at 10:16 a.m.

<u>Conflict of Interest Statement</u> – Chair Ann Gilstrap asked if any Board Member wishes to speak to the appearance of any actual or potential conflicts of interest. There were none stated. Ms. Gilstrap reminded Board members to recuse themselves when action on a staff member, family, or friend is under consideration by the Board. She also reminded Board members that they should refrain from participation in any discussions in which they may have a potential or existing conflict of interest.

### **Approval of Minutes - Janice Jones**

Minutes for the February 6, 2009 meeting were sent to all Board Members.
