**REGISTERED ENVIRONMENTAL HEALTH SPECIALIST
OCTOBER 2016 EXAM APPLICATION FORM**

The Registered Environmental Health Specialist exam is designed to assure that Environmental Health Specialists are qualified, competent, and properly prepared to perform the duties and responsibilities of the position.

In order to become a Registered Environmental Health Specialist in North Carolina, you must be:

- Registered as an Environmental Health Specialist Intern
- Complete specified continuing education and training
- Achieve a passing score on a comprehensive exam (REHS exam) within three years of being registered as an Intern

The exam consists of:

- NEHA multiple-choice exam (which counts 50% of the final score)
- Essay exam (which counts 25% of the final score)
- Oral exam (which counts 25% of the final score)

An applicant must score 60% or higher on each portion of the exam with an overall score of 70% or higher.
