NC State Board of Environmental Health Specialist Examiners

Minutes of March 27, 2020 Board Meeting

The North Carolina State Board of Environmental Health Specialist Examiners met on Friday, March 27, 2020 at 1:00 p.m. In an abundance of caution to address protective measures to prevent the spread of COVID 19, the meeting was held via telephone. Those in attendance were Chair Daniel Ortiz, Melanie Campen, Greg Caulder, Lisa Halbedl, William Hill, Carl Kivett, Larry Michael, Andrew Morgan, Rebecca Rosso, Phil Thompson, Felissa Vazquez, Board Attorney, John Barkley and Board Assistant Donna Coffey.

Called to Order - Chair Daniel Ortiz called the meeting to order at 1:05 p.m.

Board Action. <u>Greg Caulder made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. William Hill seconded</u> the motion. All votes affirmative.

Conflict of Interest Statement

Chair Daniel Ortiz reminded Board members to recuse themselves when action on a staff member, family, or friend is under consideration by the Board. He also reminded Board members that they should refrain from participation in any discussions in which they may have a potential or existing conflict of interest.

Executive Order No. 34 from Governor Bev Perdue

The Chair reminded board members of Executive Order No. 34 from Governor Perdue requiring appointees to attend at least 75 percent of the board's regularly scheduled meetings.

Emergency and Temporary Rulemaking

Chair, Daniel Ortiz noted that John Barkley was joining the meeting, because there have been many questions and much concern, in the light of the unknowns of COVID-19, and the Board needs to be proactive in seeking one-time Rule changes for 2020. Specifically, the Rule changes relate to (1) the requirement to obtain 15 hours of continuing education per year, (2) the requirement to pass the NCREHS exam within 3 years of registration, and (3) the requirement to take the NC Environmental Health Law Course within 4 years of registration.

Donna Coffey noted that in-person continuing education opportunities for spring and summer 2020 are being cancelled due to COVID-19, and it is unclear when new opportunities will resume. While there are online courses that are available for registrants, there is concern that not all registrants, especially retirees, have access to online offerings. Many counties have imposed travel and training restrictions for an undetermined time. Asking for a one-time Rule change to remove the 15-hour requirement would offer registrants a safety net to ensure they do not lose their registration status due to conditions they do not control. Registrants will have the option to complete continuing education courses if they have the means to do so.

She also noted that there are six individuals who are in their third year of registration and have not passed the exam. NEHA testing centers are closed, and with current stay at home orders issued by Governor Roy Cooper, it is difficult to predict when the Board would be able to hold exams in 2020. The Board has cancelled the April 17, 2020 essay/interview and it is possible that the July exam may be cancelled as well.

Regarding the Environmental Health Law Course, NC Environmental Health State of Practice (NCEHSOP) is considering not having the course in 2020, because of COVID-19. If that happens, the NCREHS Board would need to ask for a one-time extension from the current 4-year timeframe to 5-years to accommodate those who have not had an opportunity to take the class.

John Barkley advised the Board that it would need to seek an Emergency Rule change which would be effective immediately upon submission to Office of Administrative Hearings, and it would be effective for 60 days. In addition, the Board would also need to seek a Temporary Rule change for the same Rules and would be effective

until 12/31/2020. He said that he and Donna would prepare draft Rule changes for the Board to review and approve at its April 16 meeting should the Board agree to move forward with the changes.

Board Action. Phil Thompson made a motion to seek one-time Rule changes for 2020 and instructed

Donna Coffey to work on draft changes with John Barkley to present to the Board at its

April 16, 2020 meeting. Andrew Morgan seconded the motion. All votes affirmative.

Chair Report - Daniel Ortiz

Daniel noted that COVID-19 has impacted all areas of North Carolina, and that the Board should be supportive of registrants.

Vice-Chair Report - Carl Kivett
